## Lessons from Saint Thomas the Apostle


### Jesus has a message for us

Thomas walked beside Jesus for three years. He heard Christ's teachings and saw Him perform many miracles, but he still struggled to believe Jesus had risen from the grave. After he touched Christ's wounds and responded with the words "My Lord and my God," Jesus makes an important comment: "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (John 20:29). Jesus is talking about you and me! We didn't have the luxury of walking with Jesus or touching His scars. We live thousands of years removed from the events recorded in the Gospels, and Jesus recognizes the faith that it takes for us to believe. That's why He pronounces a special blessing on us for trusting Him! Sacred Scripture is full of valuable details and facts, and the more we dig into those details, the more encouragement we'll uncover. And like Thomas, our faith will be strengthened.
